

Derbyshire Spring Festival - Show Rules

To all exhibitors/contributors:

Any abusive language or behaviour towards show officials, animals or fellow competitors will result in expulsion from the showground and by entering this show you agree to abide by all of the following:

- 1 This show is not open to the public and operates under the NCPA Child and Vulnerable Adult Protection Policy.
- All persons entering the showground must have Personal & Public Liability Insurance. The Committee will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury to any animal, person or property whilst on the showground. Under NO circumstances must anyone other than the Judge, Stewards, Competitors and Grooms enter the show
- 3 In the interests of safety, excessive assistance or interference from outside the ring will not be tolerated.
- The ludges' decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing, within one hour of the class/incident & handed to the Secretary with a deposit of £30.
- The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate, cancel or divide classes as entries warrant. 5
- The Committee reserve the right to return or refuse any entry made by either post or the on-line entry system. 6
- 7 Under no circumstances will/can entries be substituted & any refunds will be totally at the discretion of the Committee and will be subject to the £10 admin charge.
- 8 In the event of postponement all entries will be carried over to the new date unconditionally.
- In the event of cancellation, refunds must be requested in writing (no emails) and should be sent with a S.A.E. enclosed to the Show Secretary within 28 days of the show date and will be subject to a £10 admin charge.
- Mountain & Moorland ponies are to be shown in accordance with the Breed Society rules.
- All ridden Show Pony classes are held in accordance with the BSPS current rule book unless otherwise stated. In foal Mares may be asked to produce a certificate of service.
- 13 Stallions may not be lead or ridden by children under the age of 14 years to qualify for PUK Championships.
- 14 All Trophies will remain the property the Show and must be signed for. They will be held for the remainder of the year and returned to the Show upon request.
- All postal entries must provide a suitable S.A.E with the correct postage for return of numbers. 15
- The Committee reserve the right to carry out random dope testing.
- 17 Dishonoured cheques will incur a £10 admin fee and may result in entries being refused in the future.
- 18 All grooms when entering the rings must wear hats & be smartly dressed.

Prize Money: RIHS Working Hunter & P(UK) Dalkeith Young Riders M&M & Amateur Riders M&M RIHS Championship Qualifier - 1st £20: 2nd £10, 3rd £5

NPS - Qualifying rounds are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by NPS members are eligible to qualify for the Final of the competition to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show, August 4th-6th 2015.

NPS qualification cards have been reinstated, current membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive most qualifications.

Riders of small stallions must be 12 years or over, riders of large stallions must be over 14 years or over.

Stallion Discs - MUST be worn in all ridden NPS classes, these may be from any UK society as long as they are easily identified or an NPS Stallion Disc - They MUST be worn on the bridle.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships. To be judged under the Rules of the NPS. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification can be awarded no lower than first Reserve. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

Ponies Association (UK) - "The 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each qualifying class will qualify"

Oualification tickets will be awarded in the ring.

1st, 2nd & 3rd placed horses/ponies will qualify for the Supreme Championships 2015 and the Winter Classic 2016. Competitors in qualifying positions, who are not current members of Ponies (UK), must become members before time of entry.

SPECIAL AWARDS: NCPA* rosettes will be awarded in classes 3, 18 & 22 (NCPA Badge to be worn and current membership card to be produced in the ring).

This Show is a Qualifier for Equifest 2015 to be held at the East of England Showground, Peterborough. The two highest placed exhibits, not already qualified, will qualify for the relevant final; M&M In-hand, Open M&M, M&M LR/FR, M&M WHP.

Not to have won a first prize of more than £5.00 or qualified for the NPS M&M Leading Rein Final before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead Rein to be attached to the noseband only. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

- Class 2 The NPS/HorseQuest UK Ltd M&M Novice First Ridden National Championship.

 First Ridden Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cms. Registered in their

 Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest and Welsh

 Section A or B. Not to have won a first prize of more than £5.00 or qualified for the NPS M&M

 First Ridden Final before 1st January in the current year. Shown in a snaffle bridle. Rider not
 to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Class 3* The NPS/Micor Demolition M&M Leading Rein National Championship.
 P(UK) Lobster Pot M&M Lead Rein Supreme Championship 2015 & Winter Classic 2016.
 Open Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Registered in their Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest and Welsh Section A or B. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead Rein to be attached to the noseband only. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Class 4 The NPS/Micor Demolition M&M First Ridden National Championship.
 P(UK) Brineton M&M First Ridden Supreme Championship 2015 & Winter Classic 2016.
 Open Mountain & Moorland, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cms.
 Registered in their Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest and Welsh Section A or B. To be shown in a snaffle bridle. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Registered with their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Section A, B, C or D. Rider any age. (Please see Rule 7 of the current P(UK) Rule Book).

- Class 11 M&M Small Breeds. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A or B.
- Class 12 M&M Large Breeds. Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Section C or D

Championship: 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 11 & 12 to compete.

P(UK) M&M Dalkeith Young Riders & Amateur Riders Royal International Horse Show

Judges: Mrs A Squires (Perf); Mrs J Crane(Conf)

These classes are held under the current rules of Ponies Association (UK).

Owners, riders and ponies must be current member of P(UK) before the date of the show in order to compete in these classes. Open to Mountain and Moorland ridden stallion (intermediate class only), Mares and geldings, 4 years and over. Registered with their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh section A, B,C or D. The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first five will receive notification of their qualification for the RIHS Young Riders M&M Ridden & P(UK) RIHS Amateur Riders M&M Finals at the RIHS Hickstead July 30th 2015.

The Amateurs Riders Final is open to riders who for showing purposes have not engaged in a training programme for riders/horses/ponies, livery, buying/selling or dealing of horses/ponies as a means of deriving a source of income since 1st August 2014.

It is expected that exhibitors will enter into the true spirit of this competition and trainers and producers must not enter the ring during the judging process. The Directors reserve the right, in their absolute discretion, to refuse an exhibitors entry should they be in contravention of this rule in the Directors considered opinion.

- Class 13 **P(UK) Intermediate M&M**. Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, registered with their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Section A, B, C or D. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before the 1st January in the current year (see rule 7 of the current P(UK) Rule book).
- Class 14 **P(UK) M&M Large Breeds**. Mare and Gelding 4 years old and over, registered with their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Section C or D. Riders not to have attained their 18th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.
- Class 15 **P(UK) M&M Small Breeds**. Mare and Gelding, 4 years old and over, registered with their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh section A and B. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year (see rule 7 of the current P(UK) Rule book).

Young Riders Championship. 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 13-15 to compete.

Class 16 **P(UK) Amateurs Riders Final.** Mountain & Moorland ridden Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stub Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Section A, B, C or D. riders any age.

The NPS/Dargaval M&M Young Open Ridden Pony National Championship.

To be kindly judged by Mrs N Oldershaw

Stallions, Mare and Geldings, 4 years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Book. Rider any age, except stallions (see rules in section A 3.2). The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter this competition but only ponies owned by NPS members can qualify for the final. The highest placed pony, owned by an NPS member, in each class goes forward to the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line, which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than third place.

A pony is not eligible to compete if it has qualified for:

- i) The M&M Ridden Championship final at Horse of the Year Show
- ii) The M&M Supreme Ridden Championship final at Olympia
- iii) The M&M Ridden Championship Final at Longines Royal International Horse Show If a Dargavel pony subsequently qualifies for HOYS, RIHS or Olympia it becomes ineligible for the final.

Ponies may compete in this competition for one year without de-novicing.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced - wear a <u>white armband</u>. **Championship**. 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 17-19 to compete.

The NPS/Picton Stud M&M Novice Ridden National Championship

Stallions, Mare and Geldings, 4 years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Book. A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i) Won an open NPS affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class.
- ii) Won a Ridden class at an Olympia. Horse of the Year Show or RIHS qualifying round.
- iii) Oualified for the Horse of the Year Show or RIHS Ridden classes.
- iv) Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship Show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).
- v) Qualified for the M&M Ridden Championship final at Olympia in previous years
- vi) If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS in its second year it is immediately denoviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.

Ponies for classes 20 - 24 are to be shown in a snaffle bridle

- Class 20 **Stallion, Mare or Gelding**. 4 Years Old & over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland.
- Class 21 **Stallion, Mare or Gelding.** 4 Years Old & over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Welsh Sec A or B.
- Class 22* **Stallion, Mare or Gelding.** 4 Years Old & over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of New Forest or Connemara.
- Class 23 **Stallion, Mare or Gelding.** 4 Years Old & over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Fell, Highland or Dales.
- Class 24 **Stallion, Mare or Gelding.** 4 Years Old & over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Welsh Sec C or D.

Minimum height of fences 61cm (2') and maximum height of fences 84cms (2'8"). These classes are designed to encourage the horse/pony and rider to perform stylishly.

Class 28 **Mares & Geldings**. 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cms, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Book.

NPS/Area 5 Intermediate Working Hunter Pony National Championship Stallions, mares and geldings, five years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Book. Ponies may be measured at the Judge's discretion. The pony never to have qualified for the NPS M&M Working Hunter Pony (Horse of the Year Show or RIHS) finals before 1st January in the current year.

- Class 29 Ponies not exceeding 122cms.
- Class 30 Ponies exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms.
- Class 31 Ponies exceeding 133cm but not exceeding 143cms.

 Open to pure bred M&M stallions, mares and geldings, five years old or over.

NPS/NAF M&M Working Hunter Pony Royal International Horse Show Championship.

Stallions, mares and geldings five years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society Stud Book. Ponies may be measured at the Judge's discretion. Rider any age, except stallions (see rules in Section A 3.2). Riders may only ride one pony in each class.

The owner has to be a member of the NPS for the pony to enter this competition. (NB At the final at Hickstead the rider must also be a NPS member). The highest placed pony in each class goes forward to the final at RIHS. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line that has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than third place. (NB Qualification has to be verified by the NPS Office, within 8 weeks of qualifying the pony's JMB height certificate must be sent to the NPS Office for validation. Entries are the responsibility of the owner and are made directly to RIHS).

- Class 33 Ponies exceeding 143cms.
- Class 34 Ponies exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms.
- Class 35 Ponies exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms.
- Class 36 Ponies not exceeding 122cms.
