### **SPORTS HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN**

This Show is affiliated to SPORT HORSE BREEDING OF GREAT BRITAIN and all Hunter Classes will be judged under the Society's 2016 Rules.

The Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Working Hunter and Amateur Hunter classes are qualifying events for the **Royal International Horse Show 2016**, and only horses registered on the current year Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. The two highest placed horses in the Small Hunter, Lightweight, Middleweight and Heavyweight classes will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. The three highest placed horses in the Working Hunter Hunter class will qualify. In the Amateur hunter Class **the two highest placed smalls, the two highest placed lightweights, the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify.**

Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and for the RIHS qualifying classes, owners and riders must be members of the Society. Day Ticket = £30 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 1 show in the year – it covers owner and rider membership together with horses registration for that show).

### **S.H.B.(G.B) IN THE NORTH WEST – RIDDEN POINTS COMPETITION**

The following classes at the show: WORKING HUNTER; RIDDEN SPORT HORSE; RIDDEN HUNTER, are included in the S.H.B.(G.B) in the North West Ridden Points Competition. Points will be awarded to 1st - 4th places in each class. Horses can compete in any of the above classes. An award will be made to the horse attaining the highest number of points overall. To qualify horses that are not registered at the time of the show must be registered or over stamped with SHB (GB) by 30 September 2016.

### **BRITISH SKEWBALD AND PIEBALD SOCIETY**

This Society is affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association. Classes 6-9 will be judged under BSPA rules, download from [www.bsponline.com](http://www.bsponline.com). Rider age is taken as 1st Jan. All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA and in possession of a Red Stallion I.D.card. For class 9 all stallions must be graded with a recognized equine society. No rider under 14 yrs may exhibit a stallion in any class. Membership and Qualification cards MUST be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will disqualify any competitor and their Qualification handed down to the next unqualified competitor as appropriate. Spurs may not be worn in any pony classes. Ponies 153cms or under (Shetlands exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate. RIHS Schedules [www.Hickstead.co.uk](http://www.Hickstead.co.uk). No lead reins.

### **EQUIFEST**

This Show is a qualifier for Equifest 2015 to be held at East of England Showground, Peterborough. The 2 highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the relevant final M&M In-hand, Riding Pony Breeding, Open M&M, M&M Lead Rein, M&M First Ridden, Ridden Hacks, M&M WHP, SP, SP LR, SP FR, SHP, WHP, Cobs, Hunter Weights, PBA Ridden and Ridden Coloureds, Intermediate Show Riding Type, Intermediate Show Hunter Type, Riding Horse, Small Ridden Hunter.

### **BSPS – BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY**

This Show is affiliated to the BSPS (Affiliation No: 105/16) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

- This Show is a qualifier for the 2016 BSPS Championships Show to be held at Arena UK.
- 1st and 2nd prizewinners only in the Open Lead Rein, Open First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open 122cm, 133cm 143cm, 153cm Show Hunter Ponies, and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizewinners in the Intermediate Classes, Heritage Mountain & Moorland Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes and the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and

4th prizewinners in the Mixed Height Novice WHP, Mixed Height Novice Heritage WHP, will qualify for the BSPS Championships provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 23 and 28 and ridden by a BSPS member.

**RULE 23.** Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid JMB Certificate before the date of the championship they qualify for. • **BSPS “Classic Security UK Ltd” CHALLENGE** This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge, the highest placed pony in Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open SHP, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, Open WHP, Open Intermediate SRT, SH and WH and the Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes that has not qualified for the 2015 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class, will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the BSPS Challenge, the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony. If after qualifying a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the CHALLENGE.

• **BSPS PREMIER LEAGUE** This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Premier League, the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify in the Open Lead Rein & First Ridden Show Ponies, the Open Show Pony, the Lead Rein of Hunter Type, the Open Show Hunter Ponies, the Intermediate SRT, SH & WH, the Cradle & Nursery Stakes, the Open Working Hunter Ponies, Open Heritage Lead Rein, Open Heritage First Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden, Open Heritage WHP classes.

• **BSPS CHAMPIONS OF CHAMPIONS** This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Champion of Champions, the Champion Mini Show Pony, the Champion Open Show Pony, Champion Intermediate, Champion Mini WHP, the Champion SHP, the Champion Open WHP/WH will qualify.

(To be shown in their natural state) hogged cobs not exceeding 153cms. No spurs. Judge will not ride. Display required. No leading reins permitted.

#### **CLASS 7 BSPA RIHS PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 153CMS (PLAITED)**

No spurs. Judge will not ride. Display required. No leading reins permitted

#### **CLASS 8 BSPA RIHS LIGHTWEIGHT/MIDDLEWEIGHTS/HEAVYWEIGHT**

#### **CLASS 10 BLUE CHIP FLAT RIDDEN SPORT HORSE - SHB QUALIFIER**

Blue Chip 4, 5 or 6 year old and over flat ridden sport horse. Horses to be shown on the flat, will not be required to jump. Note: Horses have to be registered with SHB (GB), owners and riders have to be SHB(UK) members. Horses will not be ridden by the judge but will be required to give a short individual show of walk, trot and canter of approximately 1 minute to be awarded marks out of a possible 20 for each pace. Lengthened strides in trot and canter must be shown. All horses are required for a conformation assessment to be awarded marks out of a possible 50.

Vouchers: 1st £30, 2nd £10, 3rd £10, 4th £10, 5th £10, 6th £10. Rosettes to 6th place.

A Blue chip cap and qualifying rosette will be awarded to every competitor who qualifies.

A horse may only qualify once and if already qualified the qualification will pass down the line – the best 4 year old, 5 year old and 6 year old and over, enabling 3 horses to qualify for the finals per qualifying class.

#### **CLASS 11 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER - SHB QUALIFIER**

A mare, gelding or stallion (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail) four years old and over not to have won a total of £100, excluding championship prize money, (or equivalent values) in prize money in any SHB(GB) affiliated Working Hunter Class, or more than 5 BE points or 200 BS points, at home or equivalent abroad before 1st January in the relevant year. Fences in Novice Working Hunter classes should have a minimum height of 0.85m (2'9") and a maximum height of 1.00m (3'3"). Working

Hunters may compete 'Hors Concours' in Novice Working Hunter classes in the jumping phase only at the discretion of the show secretary but the horse cannot compete in any other Working Hunter classes for the duration of that show.

## **Royal International Horse Show, SHB, NCPA & Equifest Qualifier**

**Entry Fee £35 /Show Day £45**

**CLASS 12 RIHS QUALIFIER' WORKING HUNTER** A mare, gelding or stallion (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail) 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms (14.2hh approx) to be judged in accordance with the rules herein set out. Grade A Show Jumpers or Advanced Event horses are not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes. Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A Show Jumper or Advanced Event Horse as at 1st January in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes.

The maximum total points available is 100. This is made up of: jumping Points = Max 40 points, Style and Presence whilst jumping = Max 20 points, Conformation = Max 20 points. Horses with a minus score may not be required for second phase of the class at the discretion of the judge. Under no circumstances should a horse with a minus score be in a qualifying position. Fences to be a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 12 in number and a max height 1.14m (3' 9") at the discretion of the Judge. Fences should have a natural appearance and not be easily dislodged. No un-numbered obstacle can be included in the course. The manner of going to be taken into account. No change of rider or tack will be allowed (unless a horse is ridden under side saddle, in which case, in order to allow the Judge to ride, the saddle may be changed for the riding phase only). 60 points are awarded for the go round, ride and conformation, If there are two judges, Judge A awards a maximum of 20 for ride, Judge B awards a maximum of 20 for conformation and both judges assess ride/manners for which a maximum score of 20 can be awarded. A rider can ride up to two horses in the jumping phase but then must select only one horse to take forward into the ride and conformation section if so required (no change of rider is allowed). A skull cap or hat and safety harness according to the current approved BSI or European Standard must be worn by ALL competitors in the jumping phase of the Class. No hind boots or bandages of any description are allowed in the collecting ring, warm up or in the actual class. On completion of the jumping phase all clear rounds and any other horses the judge may require should be asked to return to the ring.

This does not apply to Novice Working Hunter Classes. Any horse that qualifies for Horse of the Year Show in a Ridden Hunter Class (not including Working Hunter Classes) will not be eligible to compete in Novice classes from 1st January the following year, but horses that qualified for HOYS as a 4 year old are exempt.
