Awards:

Rosettes to 6th place in all classes.

A special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed junior 14 years and under in classes 2 – 14

A special rosette will be presented in each class to the highest placed entry who has been hunting in the 2017/18 or 2018/19 season with a pack within the Leicestershire and Rutland borders

NCPA Leicestershire and Rutland Members Rosettes will be presented to the highest placed L&R branch member in every class. GREEN armband to be worn.

An NCPA Star Rosette will be awarded in classes 4 and 12. Exhibitors must enter the ring wearing their NCPA badge and present their current year's membership card to the judge. BLUE armband to be worn.

An NCPA Registered Rosette will be awarded in classes 6 and 14. It is a condition of entry that the pony's NCPA registered number be stated on the entry form and pink cards must be presented in the ring. RED armband to be worn.

Ring 1 (Indoors)

Class 1. BEGINNERS WORKING HUNTER 35 - 45cm

Open to horses and ponies 4 years old and over, who have not won any working hunter class over 65cm. Riders any age. To be judged as one class, but rosettes awarded separately as follows:

- (i) Riders 10 years and under – lead reins permitted
- (ii) Riders 11 years and over

Class 2. UNAFFILIATED WORKING HUNTER 50 - 60cm

Open to horses and ponies 4 years old and over, riders any age.

Class 3. UNAFFILIATED WORKING HUNTER 65 - 70cm

Open to horses and ponies 4 years old and over, riders any age.

Judge: Mrs C Scott (Jump), and Mrs F Holton (Conf)

Class 4. THE B.S.P.S HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND NOVICE WHP

Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cm. Riders any age.

Class 5. THE B.S.P.S HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND NOVICE WHP

Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over exceeding 122cm but not exceeding 133cm. Riders any age.

Class 6. THE B.S.P.S HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND NOVICE WHP

Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over exceeding 133cm but not exceeding 143cm. Riders any age.

Class 7. THE B.S.P.S HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND NOVICE WHP

Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over exceeding 143cm. Riders any age.

Championship A First and Second prizes in classes 4 – 7 to compete

Class 8. THE B.S.P.S HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RESTRICTED WHP

Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over exceeding 143cm. Riders any age.

Class 9. THE B.S.P.S HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RESTRICTED WHP
Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over not exceeding 143cm. Riders any age.

Class 10. THE B.S.P.S HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RESTRICTED WHP
Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over not exceeding 133cm. Riders any age.

Class 11. THE B.S.P.S HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RESTRICTED WHP
Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cm. Riders any age.

1st prizewinners in class 8-11 will qualify for the BSPS 50th Anniversary Championship

Class 12. THE B.S.P.S HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN WHP *MIXED HEIGHT*
Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section. Fences heights adjusted for each height section. See rule 385 in BSPS 2018 Rulebook.

Championship B First and Second prizes in classes 8 – 12 to compete

Class 13. UNAFFILIATED WORKING HUNTER 75 - 85cm
Open to horses and ponies 4 years old and over, riders any age.

Class 14. UNAFFILIATED WORKING HUNTER 90 – 100cm
Open to horses and ponies 4 years old and over, riders any age.

Class 15. THE B.S.P.S. NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY *MIXED HEIGHT*
Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158 cms. Riders must jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section. Riders of ponies over 148cm must declare if they are competing in the 153cms or the Intermediate section. Please see rule 37 in BSPS 2018 Rulebook. Sections will run Large to Small. *Class will be split if entries permit*

Affiliations

BSPS

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society ("B.S.P.S."), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Rules of the B.S.P.S., including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S. All rules as per the 2018 B.S.P.S Rule & Show Handbook, except for any new or amended rules as included in this Schedule.

The following Classes 4-12, 15 are B.S.P.S. qualifiers for the 2019 B.S.P.S. Winter Championships Show. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizewinners will qualify in the Novice classes 4-7, and in the restricted classes 8-11. Cards to be presented in the ring to ponies that qualify for the Restricted classes, these cards to be sent in with entries for the Winter Championships.

Animals must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S. Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid J.M.B. Certificate (excluding heritage) before the date of the Championship they qualify for.

Riders to be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.

RULES FOR RESTRICTED QUALIFICATION IN THE RESTRICTED WORKING HUNTER PONY/INTERMEDIATE W.H. CLASSES:- Animals eligible for the Restricted W.H.P. or Restricted Int. W.H. must NOT have been placed 1st to 8th at the R.I.H.S. or H.O.Y.S. in 2016/2017/2018.

RULES FOR RESTRICTED QUALIFICATION IN THE HERITAGE W.H.P. CLASSES:- Animals eligible for the Restricted Heritage W.H.P. Classes must NOT have been placed 1st to 8th at the R.I.H.S. or H.O.Y.S. in the Heritage M&M W.H.P. Classes in the PREVIOUS or CURRENT year.

B.S.P.S PREMIER LEAGUE – 1st-4th prizewinners in the OPEN classes will qualify for the BSPS PREMIER LEAGUE at the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

Show Rules

It is a condition of entry that all Exhibitors agree to be bound by the rules hereunder.

- The organising committee accept no responsibility whatsoever for any loss, injury or damage to any person or property whilst on the showground, car parks or approaches.
- The organising committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason and will not tolerate bad behaviour of any kind.
- Entry Fees will not be refunded, and it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure the entry is correct, eligible and that they are available for their classes, unless a veterinary certificate is produced.
- In the event of the show being cancelled, refunds will be made less an administration fee of £3.00 per entry.
- Exhibitors must take into consideration any classes that may clash. If this occurs, they must nominate which class they wish to compete in.
- No nomination or substitute entries will be accepted.
- The Judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing with a deposit of £30.00 CASH. (to be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled) within 30minutes of the class taking place.
- Entries for any affiliated classes will also be bound by the rules and conditions in force at the time of showing, applicable to the association and the class in which they are exhibiting. It is deemed by the organising committee that all competitors are conversant with all such rules, conditions and directives.
- Horses / Ponies which have been bred, leased or produced by the Judge, his/ her immediate family or employer are not eligible for that class.

- The organising committee reserve the right to amalgamate or split classes and/or alter the running order of classes as it deems fit.
- The organising committee reserve the right to substitute other Judges for those announced in the schedule for any that may be unavoidably prevented from attending. All entries are accepted on this understanding and no refund of entry fees can be made where a substitute is necessary.
- Exhibitors must enter the ring wearing the back number allocated for that class.
- A correctly fitted chinstrap MUST be worn by all competitors whilst mounted. Correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats nos. EN1384, PAS015 or PAS accredited must be worn, unless competing under the rules of a governing society for a particular class.
- Any horse/pony which is not under adequate control of a competent rider/handler or which in any way constitutes a danger will be asked to leave the showground.
- All Stallions/Colts SHOULD be adequately bitted.
- Stallions may not be handled or ridden by a child under the age of 14 years .
- Foals must be a minimum of 3 weeks old on the day of the show.
- The organising committee reserves the right to expel any animal from a ring should it in their opinion be deemed not to be fit or under sufficient control.
- Anyone found miss-treating any animal may be asked to leave the showground and reported to the appropriate body.
- Show Canes and Whips must not exceed 75cms (30ins.) in length.
- There is to be no lunging in the collecting rings.
- Mountains and Moorland Ponies must be shown in accordance with the appropriate pertaining Breed Society Rules.
- Exhibitors must provide proof of registration on request.
- Any Perpetual Trophies must be returned to the organising committee on request and at least two months before the following years summer show, either by hand or by registered post. Any lost trophies are to be paid for at their replacement value.
- Any Dogs on the showground/box park MUST be kept on a lead and under control at all times.
- No mucking out of horse-boxes or trailers is to be undertaken anywhere on the site, please take your litter home with you.
- The use of mobile telephones in the judging rings is prohibited.
- No Horses or Ponies are to be left unattended tied to trailers/horse-boxes.
- Any exhibitor not complying with any of the show rules can be disqualified.
- All equine passports MUST accompany all Horses and Ponies whilst being transported.
- This Show operates under the NCPA Child and Vulnerable Adults protection policy.
